## Fiestas de Santa Ana y Santiago 2016

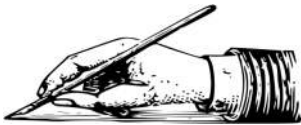

Dear family,

There's an unsaid assumption that a lot of people make, but no one like to speak: if something or someone cannot contribute in some way to a project, then the thing in question is worthless. This assumption is what has led our Holy Father, Pope Francis to coin the term "Throwaway Culture." His idea is that in a growing, worldwide culture, it has become easier and easier to "throw away" people either because these people are sick, vulnerable, or are seen as a burden. But as we see in today's Gospel. This way of thinking can take root even with the best of intentions. Martha is angry at her sister Mary for apparently doing nothing, not contributing to all of her very important chores. Now of course, Martha is doing good in attending to Jesus, but Jesus refuses to let Mary be thrown under the bus, because her way of "attending" to Him is important also. Think of the precious moments we miss at times when we become so busy, even doing good work, and we forget why we do this work and opportunities to seize and cherish a silent, still moment with our God. The Church needs both of these types of personalities and ways of life, as St. Augustine reminds us, but so does every individual. There is a lot of work to do in building up God's kingdom, but let's never do so without God.
