### *Year of Mercy Corner*

One of the major factors which reflects in today's Gospel and which still today remains a damaging reality is the formation of cliques. This can happen mentally or with actual relationships, or both. The problem out simply is an "us versus them" mentality which rules some people's lives. Sometimes people form cliques or status circles based on ethnicity, economic status, or social class. Like the rich man in the Gospel, we may be part of a clique to the detriment of our growth and to disobedience of God's call to love. As humans, it's normal to have biases, but we can be more merciful if we learn to recognize these biases and make a decision that despite them, we will seek to love all of God's children.

*"Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established  
to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go  
from our side to yours or from your side to ours."*

Dear family,

Depending on how you look at it, today's Gospel can have either a sobering or consoling effect. It is sobering because we hear of the steep consequence of neglecting our call to love and passage is consoling in that we see justice and dignity given to a rejected and oppressed person. After the death of the rich man, he is surprised to "wake" to the fact that Lazarus and him are in two different places. It is a shocking anomaly that they now live with a distance between them that can be traversed. And based on his pleading with Abraham, the rich man is also caught off guard by the fact that he is in a place of torment, hence his frantic need to go and warn his brothers. My dear family, there should be no surprise anywhere in this story for those who realize that living in love is a huge part of what it means to follow Christ and be human. As for the chasm experienced in the afterlife, also not a surprise since the chasm begins back in this world where Lazarus was rejected, neglected and left to starve. If anything, this passage shows that the afterlife is an honest continuation of this life where our limits of love and intimacy are clearly drawn for us. But while this reading remains a warning, we should not be frightened, but we should be aware. Be aware always that we do not sacrifice human dignity for earthly comfort and that lasting happiness cannot be found in anything created.
