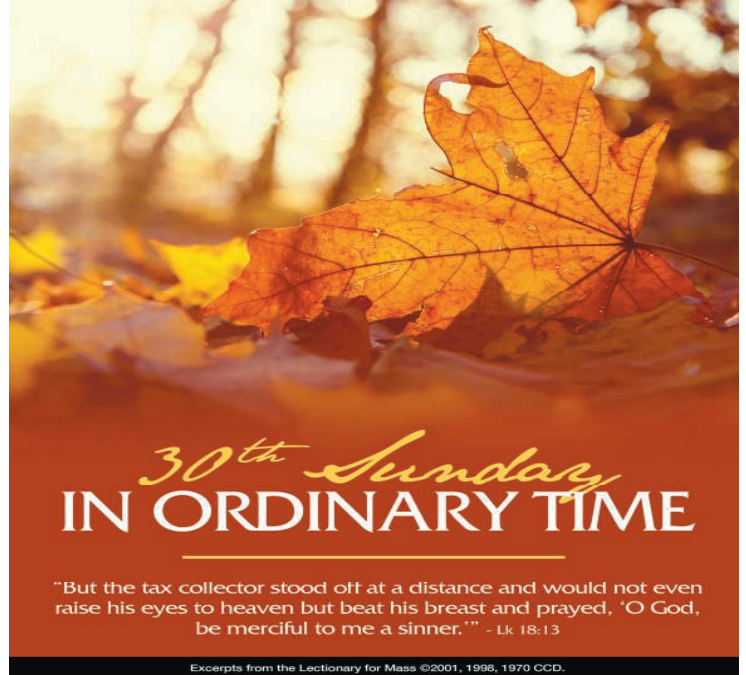

As we seek to be more merciful people, we often imagine exotic situations where we find ourselves a missionary among a foreign tribe of people ministering to their needs. When we think of the heroic and merciful St. Mother Theresa we get the image locked in our mind of a person traveling to a poverty stricken place to take care of the sick and homeless in the streets. And these actions are all virtuous and merciful for sure. But the first reading reminds us of an important fact: our chance to be merciful already exist in our own world, our own community. We may not know actual widows or orphans, but we can name and point to the forgotten, the voiceless, and the marginalized among us. God hears the voice of these little ones, so should we. Your opportunity to be the face of God’s mercy is before you, now act!

“Oh God, be merciful to me a sinner.”

Dear family,

As a priest I often get the request to pray for people’s needs and concerns, and rightfully so. It belongs to the priestly vocation to intercede on behalf of others, especially those who are entrusted to us. When people usually ask me for prayers then I will often agree and immediately ask for their prayers as well. On one occasion a man told me, “You don’t want my prayers, I only need yours.” I asked him why he would say such a thing because I need prayers also. His response: “I believe you, but you are closer to God.” Perhaps the problem is that I was not raised with the faith, but I was utterly shocked by what this man said. On top of knowing this man was mistaken in his assumption, I also knew my own sin well enough to know I need tons of work in getting closer to God. As in today’s Gospel, we may be shocked to see our assumptions upset when we see the Pharisee’s pride and the tax collector’s piety. The tax collector best keeps the faith because he has not forgotten that he needs God and not vice versa. And as for the Pharisee, his prayer is quite inauthentic in that he addresses a God in a prayer which itself expresses his self-sufficiency. The Pharisee’s life may be entangled in the life of the temple, but he is far from the embrace of a God who requires our humility. No one is entitled to a state of holiness except God. If we desire holiness, then we must decrease and He must increase. No title ensures our closeness to God and while I am glad people hold priests to higher standards, this should not withhold anyone from seeking the heroic holiness they are called to live.
