Dear family, Today we are blest to enter into the season of Advent. Our churches and the ministers will be adorned in purple: a sign of penance and reflection. The church environment will be a simple one, with a few symbols for the season including the advent wreath with the four candles for the four Sundays leading up to the birth of Our Lord.
