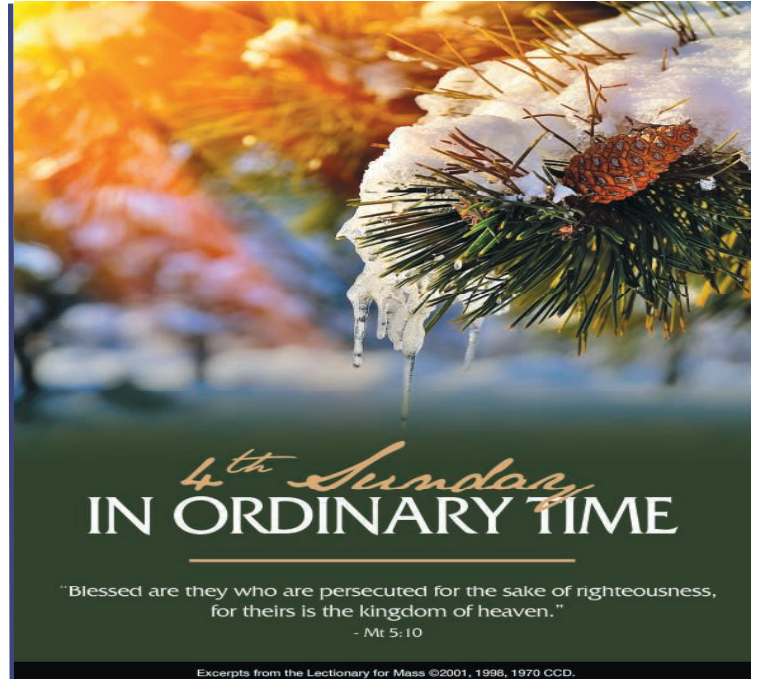

“Did you know?”

Did you know that in addition to diocesan priests, there are religious priests as well? How would you know the difference? If you are simply receiving a sacrament or attending a Mass, you probably wouldn't notice any difference at all. That's because like diocesan priests, religious priests have the same “abilities” are just as much priests and any other. However, unlike diocesan priests, religious priests have a different orientation. While diocesan priests are enrooted and invested in their diocese and called to serve in their assignments and parishes, religious priests are first and foremost called to serve their fellow brothers and sisters of their order. They all join a particular family and from that family life, they have services to others. Religious priests also have different careers, some are teachers, some are scientists, some are preachers giving missions and retreats, some serve in administrative positions. They are also called “religious” because they belong to an order. Examples of an order would be the Franciscans or the Dominicans. The reality of Jesus' priesthood has different aspects and they are seen in all these different types of priests. Remember to pray for all priests: diocesan, religious, retired and deceased.

Dear family,

At first glance, the list Jesus puts forth in today's Gospel is strange. It doesn't seem to sit well with our common understanding. We may even ask the question, “Why would an all-powerful God define success in terms of weakness.” What we do not realize, however, is that God does not need to ask our opinion or permission to define things. Contrary to what we think, these

attributed called “beatitudes” are His definition of success. Further, at no point does Jesus ever use the word “weak.” We are the ones who imply it. Also, with this model Jesus takes into our account our brokenness. One need not belong to an elite club to follow Jesus; it's almost assumed that he will take the outcasts. No one is incapable of doing amazing things to build His kingdom. Finally, friends, Jesus calls us knowing we are imperfect. How many times do I hear that people shy away from ministry or the sacraments because they feel unworthy, I have a response for that excuse: get over yourselves! Our worth is not found in what we earn but in who we are as gifted Children of God. As with the apostles, God calls us by name knowing full well what he is getting into. He knows we are imperfect, He knows we have struggles (some of them ongoing), but His persistent love for us makes us worthy and even capable to do so much good, even through our brokenness. The world can be a tough place to catch a break, but in Christ we are strengthened, called, supported, held up, sustained, and commissioned to be His presence in the world. What an honor, and it is yours, O Christian!
