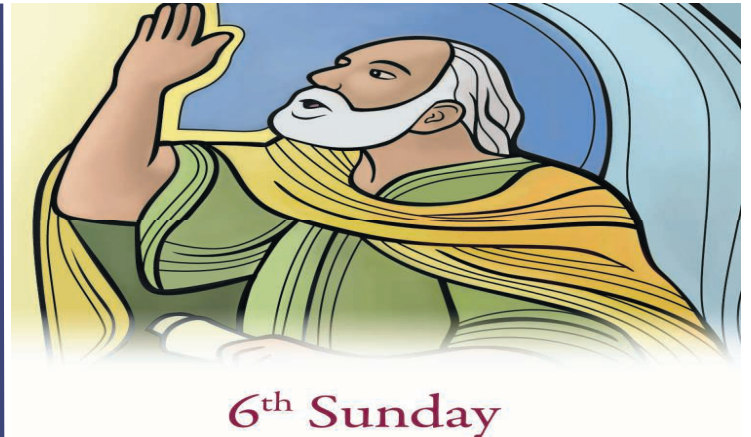

Did you know each parish has its own physical boundaries. That is to say, beyond the physical plant and campus of each parish, its services and jurisdiction of the pastor extends to certain boundaries. In our parish of Guadalupe for example, our parish boundaries extend to the South up until Este Es Road, East until the Colfax County Line, North to the Old Blinking Light and West to just before Ojo Caliente. In my authority and responsibility, I must see to it that the Church does it’s best to provide for the spiritual needs of all people living in these confines. Now of course every priest should serve all of God’s people, however these are my immediate responsibilities. The purpose of these boundaries are simple for the sake of assigning responsibility and in some sense to break up the duties so that each pastor and parish can have a certain sense of autonomy and subsidiarity.

Dear Family,  
Oftentimes, Our Blessed Lord, not unlike the celebrities today is questioned by the “media” about their beliefs or opinions. Driven by sensationalism, the media takes their first word or phrase that will bring the most attention and ignores the entire context and so begins the confusing snowball effect of

misunderstandings and assumptions. Without defense or room for an apology, people make Jesus what they would like Him to be, mostly because who He really is does not always fit nice and neatly into our categories. One case of these unfortunate assumptions is when Jesus is touted as an anarchist, that is someone who is against any and all regulations or governing of peoples. People point to examples of Jesus dispensing His disciples at certain moments and immediately present Him as the leader against institutionalism. So then how are we supposed to understand our Gospel today in light of a Jesus who has been known to usurp authority? The answer lies in the middle between anarchy and legalism. Jesus is not an anarchist because at times He works outside the law, like any dispensation sometimes the letter of the law is relaxed so that it does not do more damage than harm. Other times he extends the scope of the law (e.g. today’s Gospel) so that people do not neglect the law’s aim while considering themselves justified. The bottom line is this: it’s all about communion. Whatever increases and strengthens our communion with God and others in a natural way to be commended while whatever hurts our relationships and puts distance should be avoided. Let us learn to respect the laws God gives us while respecting and loving more He who gave them to us.
