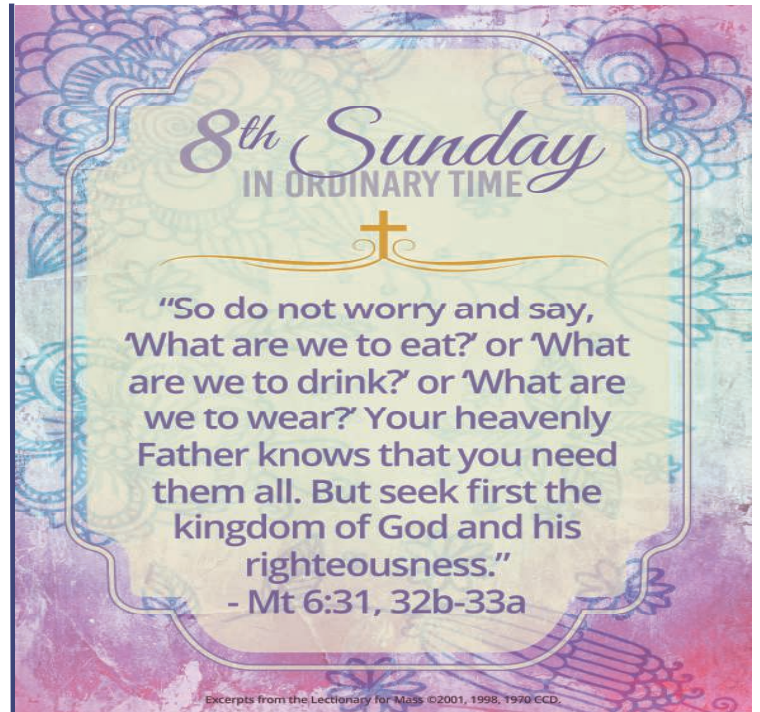

“Did you know?”

The second way Jesus is present in each Mass is in the person of the priest. When each priest is ordained he is told by the Church that he is to be an alter Christus, “another Christ.” This is why the priest wears vestments and uses the words of the Church and Christ during the Mass. All of these practices are like a big neon sign above the priest saying “don’t look to me, look to the One who I represent.” Probably the most powerful example of this presence of Christ in the priest is at the consecration when over the bread and wine the priest says “Take this is my body and my blood.” Speaking in the first person shows the intimate bond between Christ and the priest and between His sacrifice and the offering of each ordained man to the service of God and His people. Let us pray for our priests who take on an extraordinary role, that they may fulfill it with grace and humility.—Fr. Daniel

Dear family,

This week we enter that time of renewal and transformation called “Lent.” The name itself refers to this time of year when new life is budding, well at least in most places. This season is to be a spring cleaning, not the simple patchwork or touch ups done to address particular issues, but a deep cleaning. Lent is the sort of interior cleaning which addresses both the cob webs in the attic and the scuff marks on the base boards. To get started, however, we need to recognize our need to be swept, wiped, sanitized and inspected, that is to say, we need to admit we all have areas for improvement. What are yours? This Lent our theme will be Binding Wounds and Healing Hearts: Under the Care of Jesus, the Physician. And just as with visiting any doctor, we have to submit to his care. Jesus reminds us in the Gospel today that often, thinking ourselves completely in control, we forget our relationship with God and His care for us. That is to say, our ability to worry is disproportionate with our ability to trust Him. This will be the first step before entering Lent that we submit ourselves (in mind and heart) to the spiritual examination we need, not the one we always want. Let us be humble and ask God for healing while trusting He has our well-being in mind.
