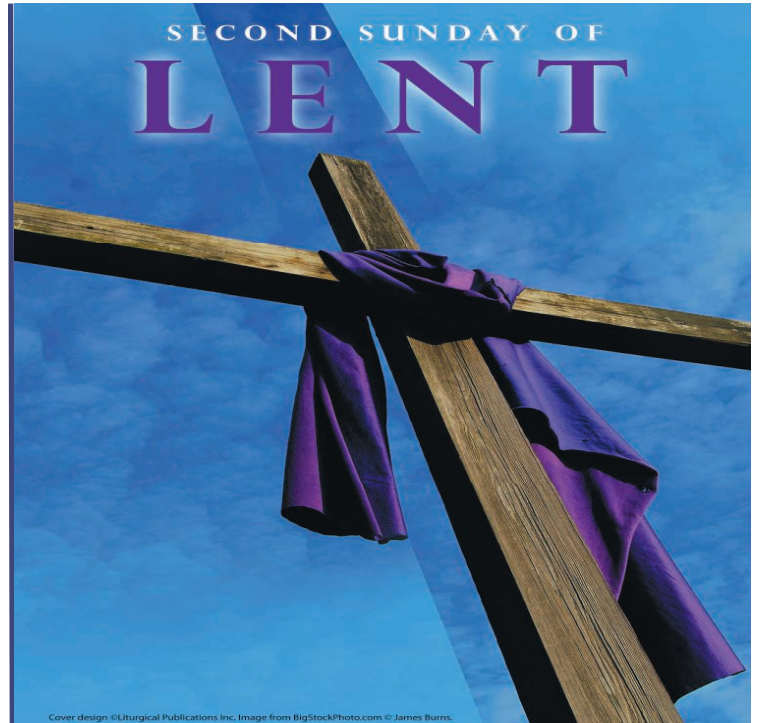

Dear family,

As we continue to journey through Lent, we continue to look to Jesus as our doctor and healer. Other than emergency situations, it's not unusual for a person looking at a procedure to carefully consider the right surgeon to do the job. For most surgeons and doctors, their credentials are on clear display, often in their offices or clinic. Now it might seem funny to ask about Jesus' qualifications (Him being God and all), but in a journey of trust and conversion such as we are on this lent, it never hurts to remember Who it is that is working on us. Today's Gospel gives us an important reminder about Jesus' qualifications. Firstly, we notice just how awesome the sign must have been to the three apostles. Up to this point, they had known Jesus to be a powerful teacher and even seen him do some amazing things, but this episode was on a whole different level. In His life on earth, Jesus was approachable and didn't make a huge entrance so to speak, at least by His appearance. In His deepest nature, however, lied a glory beyond all telling. Jesus is always the son of God sent forth from the Father, but in this story the disciples are reminded of this awesome reality behind the seemingly ordinary teacher they follow. This speaks to Our Lord's humility. The appearance of Elijah and Moses also point to Our Lord's authority. Elijah representing the prophets and Moses, the law, with Jesus in a dignified place between them means He is the fulfillment of the past and all the people's hopes and dreams. This also means, as the Church reveals, that Jesus is the fullness of a revelation, such that when Jesus speaks, He needs to medium. So He carries a level of authority about everything the likes of which no other mere human could ever match. Sometimes I fear we treat God's words to us as a piece of advice among others, but when one really considered the reality, Jesus' "opinion" is the only one that counts. Why not entrust yourself and your life to Him?
