"Did You Know"

Did you know that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick or Extreme Unction can be given to anyone with a serious sickness. The Church has developed her doctrine over time, not changing what we have taught before about this important sacrament but expanding it our understanding of it. It was understood before that the Anointing of the Sick was administered only when someone is in danger of death, but now it has many more uses. If any illness, either physical or mental, has seriously interrupted one's life, if one is about to go through surgery, if a condition worsens or any other condition is contracted a person can receive the anointing. While never a substitute for confession and its healing power, the Anointing of the Sick forgives all sins. Also, this sacrament is meant to given the sick person encouragement, which is healing in its own way when one is suffering. The priest uses the oil of the sick blest at the Chrism Mass every year by the local bishop.

Dear family,

I want to thank everyone for the show of support of our Lenten mission with Monsignor Raun. I hope his preaching gave you inspiration to commit deeper to your own Lenten project of healing and growing closer to Christ. Let us gather our efforts as we move forward seeking His grace when we grow weak and helping others when we are feeling strong.

In our Gospel today Jesus meets up with a woman in an encounter that would end up changing her life forever. We are told she was a Samaritan woman, which meant her people and the main stream Jews (to which Jesus belonged) did not usually get along. Belonging to this context, the woman was already in an awkward place in relation to the person of Jesus, but Jesus in a conversation with her overcame this and every difficulty which prevented her from living a full relationship with God. He addresses her every concern with great care, including her personal life which needed repair and healing. What we learn by Jesus in this passage is that He heals in a way that is sensitive to her needs while addressing the major obstacles which alienate her. This is some of Jesus' best medical work in that He both communicated and journeys with the woman so that at every step they are on the same page, we are taught through this story that faith is something that grows best and is most effective when it is grown organically and not forced and this is done in dialogue with God from where we are in life. As Jesus guides us this Lent toward a deeper relationship with Him and thus along a journey of healing, let us engage Him in an authentic way by listening to His voice and letting Him guide the discussion.
