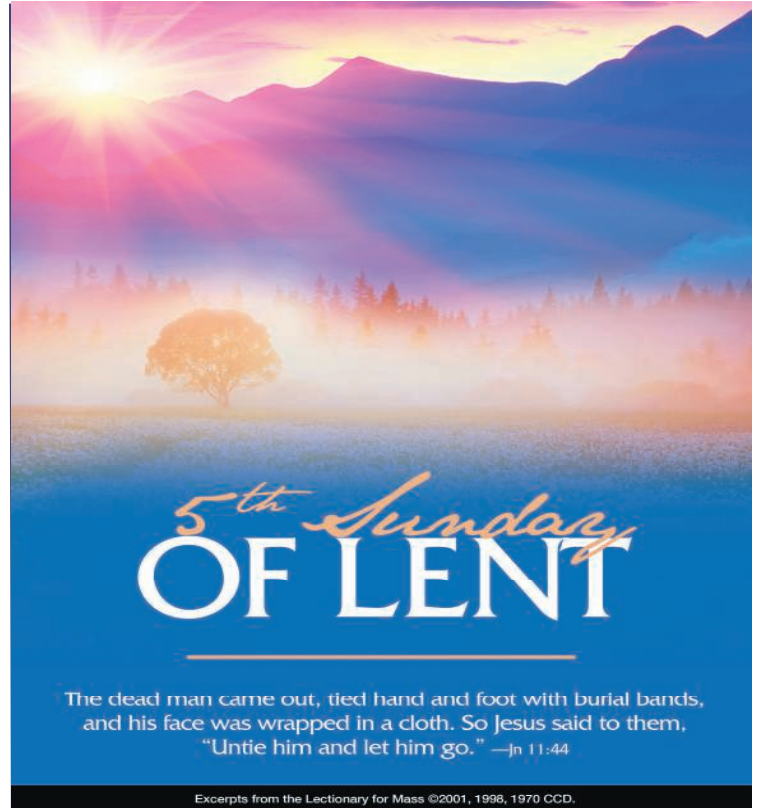

“Did you know?”

Did you know that eulogies should not be read during the funeral Mass itself, but at another appropriate time, such as at the end of the rosary. This is the case because while the funeral Mass is incredibly personal in many ways (e.g. the deceased’s name mentioned several times in the prayers), every Mass is ultimately about one person and one person only: Jesus Christ. When Supreme Court Justice Scalia recently died, his son (a priest) began the homily by welcoming people to talk about a great and amazing man. Everyone assumed he was referencing his father and his legacy, but then he said that he was talking about Christ. I have to admit, it was an excellent beginning to any sermon, especially a funeral sermon. Regardless, this is true, my friends. It is and should always be about Christ. After all, without Our Lord, why celebrate the funeral Mass at all? He is the resurrection and the life, He who first created the cosmos. Without Him there is no life, no hope for life to come. While there is much to reflect on when a person dies that we love, and while we need that time as well, the voice of Jesus must be given an audience so as to provide true hope, He who raised Lazarus from the dead.

Dear family,

With only two weeks until Easter and one until Holy Week, it seems this Lenten journey has been moving at light speed. We have been given an example of the power of Jesus’ healing words, we have seen Him heal those who feel alienated and invisible, but today we see our Physician do some of His most powerful work: he will raise the dead. There is not one of us who can avoid the reality of death in our lives, the fact of our mortality. Jesus, though, is not like the doctors we are unfortunately used to encountering. There are many cases of doctors who are not always listening to the patient. Like similar temptations in any practice or craft, it becomes easy to become rather robotic. We see this is medicine when often one will be prescribed medicine to treat symptoms instead of diligent investigation into the underlying issue. Jesus, however, is invested in His patients and He deals with issues radically, at their root. In this story of the death of His friend, Lazarus, we see Jesus showing compassion to his family and taking the time to explain to them that this cure He will bestow is not something superficial, but very familiar and known. The same Jesus who raises His friend from the dead, still weeps at his death. The same Jesus who possesses the cure, still experiences the sadness and maliciousness the disease entails. It could be said that Jesus acts authoritatively in two ways in this story, with the authority of experience and the authority of possessing a solution. Even in the worst wounds that we experience awaits a God to help us who knows the pain and the hope beyond the pain, let us praise Him!
