“Liturgical Tidbits”

Did you know that incense has a long history in the Church. We know it was used by our Jewish ancestors in liturgical rites. Even the psalms mention incense used in the rites of the old law, “may my prayer be set before you like incense...” (Psalm 141) Today in the Church we use incense for two reasons. First, they represent our prayers rising up to God and just as God finds humble hearts pleasing, so their prayers are heard by Him who finds them as “sweet.” The Church also uses incense to demark holy things. When used, the priest will incense the altar, the Gospel book, the cross, and even the people. All of these things are holy insofar as they belong to God and are used in service to Him. Incense is yet another physical sign that when we are gathered at Mass or any other liturgy, we are not doing anything normal, ordinary, or earthly. Our worship is indeed something divine and majestic, what a gift!

Today we are celebrating a beautiful devotion that has become a universal celebration for the Church. It is not always a usual practice that private revelations or devotions become part of the Church's practice. As we saw with the Jubilee Year of Mercy proclaimed by Pope Francis, God's mercy is a powerful reality that when proclaimed and realized by the faithful has a transformative power to revitalize the Church communities. Being that we are all affected by sin and weakness, mercy is a necessary medicine that we all need and find refreshing.

The Divine Mercy devotion itself was a result of a series of private revelations given to Sister Faustina Kowalska. In those revelations Our Blessed Lord revealed that His heart, like His power & knowledge, has no limits in embracing us, even in our sinfulness. In my professional opinion, which is supported by my experience in ministry, that mercy must be the constant word on the Church's lips, a Church which calls her members to such high standards and to an extraordinary mission in the world. This all boils down to the fact that for any meaningful relationship to flourish, it must be based on love and an initial acceptance of the other where they are. Let us remember the words of our Lenten missionary, Msgr.
