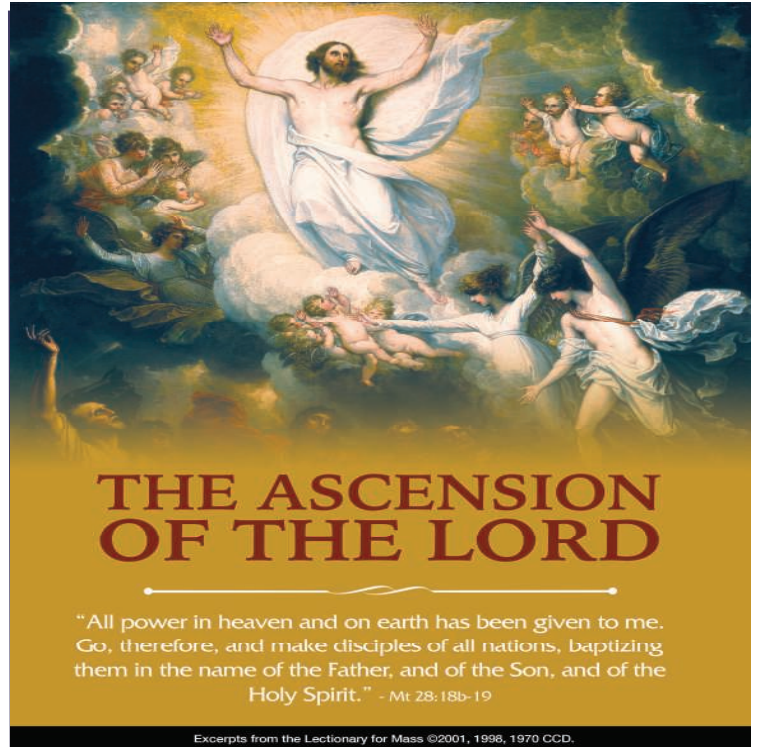

### Liturgical Tidbits

This weekend our parish has the pleasure of welcoming our summer seminarian, Deacon Jason Pettigrew. You heard me correctly, "Deacon." Before each man is ordained to the priesthood, usually about a year before, he is ordained to the diaconate. This is a very old tradition in the church and the message is that since deacons represent service, one must be a servant like Christ before being a priest. Your pastor was ordained a deacon on May 26th, 2012. And because the sacrament of Holy Orders leaves an indelible mark upon the person, I will always be a deacon. So back to Dcn. Jason, I am sure the question will come up: Is he a real deacon? The resounding answer: "yes!" You will see him assisting at Mass like Deacons Jerry and Don, he will be baptizing, preaching, and assisting also at funerals and weddings. Remember, Holy Orders is about grace, not age or experience. I would ask you to refer to him as "Deacon," even as he continues to learn and prepare for the next step.

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S

#### DESK

Dear family,

I am thrilled to welcome to the parish our seminarian for the summer, Deacon Jason Pettigrew. Dcn. Pettigrew is originally from Clovis, New Mexico. He is forty seven years old and currently attends Mt. Angel Benedictine Seminary in western Oregon. Dcn. Pettigrew will be with us June 1st through August 6th before returning to his last year of seminary. He will be ordained deacon this Wednesday, along with four other men (including another native New Mexican) at Our Lady of Lavang Parish in Albuquerque.

This Sunday we celebrate the Ascension of Our Lord into heaven. Why is this "event" important to us and how does it relate to us today? While there is nothing unusual about Our Blessed Lord being in heaven, what we celebrate today is the *way* He enters heaven. Jesus enters heaven body and soul, with His divinity and His humanity. What an honor He gives our humanity by becoming one of us and by consecrating that humanity in His ascension. However, this is not a mere honor God bestows on us, but it is the promise of a plan for our eternal life. Because Jesus is God's idea of what humanity *should be*, that is to say, because Jesus is the new *Adam*, then God's plan is that we too join God in heaven: body and soul. And in today's world, broken as it is, broken as we are, God has not given up on our humanity and shows this by the Ascension of Christ. Whereas most would consider us a lost cause as a race or a created experiment gone wrong, God Almighty still finds room for humanity in His redemptive plan and completes that plan by making "room" for us. What a gift this, dear family. The Ascension reminds us that our ultimate goal in living our faith is NOT the forgiveness of sins, but the eternal communion we are destined to share with a God who loves us. If that does not inspire hope, I am not sure what will. God bless you all.
